No Entrance Fee

This is one of the few spots on Oahu where culture, land, and daily life still overlap in a meaningful way. Kahana offers an experience that feels genuine and grounded.

Camping is by permit only, Friday through Wed. Arrive before gate closure for vehicle access.

Two easy public hiking trails are available, may be muddy, require no permits, and maps are at the Orientation Center or click the link on the side under trails.

Activities

Beachgoing, camping, dogs on leash, fishing, hiking, hunting, and sightseeing.

Facilities

Boat ramp, campsites, picnic table, restroom, showers, trash cans, and water fountain.

Prohibited

No motorized vehicles/ATV's, no alcoholic beverages, no open fires, no smoking, no day-use of picnic tables, & no commercial activities.
